

Charter Membership

Conditions for Membership Status

Requirements

1. Member must have completed a minimum of ten seasons of membership.
2. Member must be in good standing (paid in full).
3. Must apply in writing to the membership director. A Charter Membership waiting list will be developed on a first come, first served basis.
4. The number of charter memberships granted each year will depend upon the current Pool Club Waiting List. This will be determined by the Board of Directors.
5. A release must be signed to convert to the new status, relinquishing Pool Membership privileges and accepting all the conditions of Charter Membership.
6. After obtaining Charter Membership Status, they are annually required to pay Charter Membership dues (\$100/year) or their FRCC Membership will be forfeited with no refund of their bond.

Privileges

1. Each Charter family member may use the pool a maximum of four times per person per season (not transferable to other family members), and must check in with the lifeguard before doing so.
2. Charter Members are welcome to participate in all FRCC Social functions.

Restrictions

1. Initial bond and refund conditions remain unchanged.
2. Once converted to new Charter Membership status, their FRCC Membership is no longer transferable with the sale of their house.
3. If this member chooses to rejoin as a full member, they must re-apply to the Membership Director and have their name placed on the regular Club waiting list, with no priority given for previous membership status.
4. Charter Members may not bring a guest to use the pool.
